UNITE MEMBERS HAVE SAID NO TO LOW PAY



JOIN OUR ACTION ON THE 16 & 17 JULY

Unite has balloted its Local Government members and they have said a resounding Yes to industrial action and No to the pay offer

Members have rejected the 2.45% pay offer as far too low. Inflation is now running at 4.3%. Energy and food costs are running well above the rate of inflation with electricity costs up by nearly 10% and food costs by nearly 8%. Average domestic energy bills have now risen to £1,063 a year.

Members have voted and decided that enough is enough and that is why we are calling on all Unite members to support the action called for on the 16th & 17th July.

Every member needs to show Local Government employers how strong they feel and now is the time to act. Our claim was realistic and reasonable calling for an increase of 6% or 50p and hour whichever is the greater. The final offer from the employers is not realistic or reasonable and expects all our members to take a cut in their living standards.

Contact your steward, organize non-members in your workplace, join together and make a stand for decent pay and conditions.
