ARE YOU INTERESTED IN PROMOTING FAIRNESS, EQUALITY AND DIGNITY AT WORK?

If you are then why not become a Union Equality Rep (UER) and help to transform your workplace.

Unite the union is receiving matched funding from the Government's Union Modernisation Fund which involves the development of 400 new UERs throughout the union by January 2010, after which UERs will be rolled out across the whole of the union, in every region and every sector.

Developing fairness and equality in the workplace are key priorities for the union. We need elected UERs who are campaigning for equality and dignity at work and keeping members informed about equality issues and legislation

You may be an existing union workplace, learning or H&S Rep who would like to take on the role of an UER to enhance your personal skills and knowledge. But you don't need to be an existing Union Rep – you may be a union member who wants to help to tackle inequality, discrimination and bullying in the workplace.

All UERs receive fully accredited training and a 5-day regional training programme has been developed which covers all the main aspects of equality and discrimination issues and legislation. UERs will also have the option to undertake further training where the strands of equality and dignity at work are covered in more depth.
