

Industrial Action Ballot UPDATE

JULY 2010

Ballot notice deferred until the 6th August to allow time for further talks

Following a meeting with Capita on the 13th of July the Unite Senior Workplace Reps from each site met to discuss the latest position from the talks with Capita and have agreed to a further meeting with them on the 5th August.

Although no definite progress has been made on the Pensions issue we are talking through the obstacles from both perspectives and are in discussion about a possible longer term Divisional pay deal. The Senior Workplace Reps agreed at their meeting that whilst the current proposal does not resolve the fundamental issue of why members voted for an Industrial Action ballot at the 5 sites, a workable deal is still a possibility if Capita come back on the 5th with a revised offer which addresses the issues that we have raised from the original proposal. As a result it was again agreed to defer the Industrial Action Ballot until the Senior Workplace Reps meet again on the 6th of August.
