Re: Public Service Campaign of Action
Industrial Action Instructions

Due to the unilateral implementation of pay cuts by the Fianna Fáil / Green Party led Government and the further threat of cuts to pay, jobs and pension benefits, the Public Service Unions have embarked on a campaign of action to reverse these cuts and seek guarantees that no further cuts will be implemented.

Unite now intends to serve industrial action notice on Public Service Employers under the mandate received by ballot from our members to engage in Industrial Action, up to and including strike action.

Full-time Officers will serve notice to expire on Wednesday, 27th January 2010. Industrial Action will commence from **8.00am on Thursday, 28th January 2010**. The initial stages of Industrial Action are as set out in the attached Directives for the sectors. Please refer to the Directive relevant to your sector.

Should the Government fail to respond or should any of our members be victimised or disciplined, the range of Industrial Action set out in the initial stages of the campaign will be escalated and may include work place strikes.

Officers and Representatives should be holding General Workplace meetings of members and should seek to contact officials and representatives from other unions in each work place to ensure that the campaign of action is coordinated where possible to insure the maximum impact.

Workers UNITED shall never be defeated.
