Voting in the election

Anyone who was a member of **Unite the Union** on 9th August 2010 is eligible to vote. This includes retired members.

A fully postal ballot will be held during late October and November. Ballot papers must be returned to The Independent Scrutineer to arrive no later than Friday, 19th November 2010.
