## EXECUTIVE COUNCIL ELECTION 2011

In accordance with the Rules of Unite it is necessary to hold a ballot to elect members of the Unite Executive Council which will hold office from 1st May 2011 to 30th April 2014.

Members to be elected:

- 1) Regional members
- 2) Industrial Sector members
- 3) National Women's member
- 4) National Black, Asian and ethnic minority member

### VOTING IN THE ELECTION

Anyone who was a member of Unite the Union on 10th January 2011 is eligible to vote. (This does not include retired members.)

A fully postal ballot will be held during late March and April. Ballot papers must be returned to The Independent Scrutineer to arrive no later than Friday, 15th April 2011.

A list of all valid nominations made by branches/chapels and workplaces for candidates will be published with the ballot paper and on the Unite website.

Electoral Reform Services have been appointed Independent Scrutineer in accordance with the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992 by the Unite Executive Council, see their contact details below.
