

Unite Charter for Young People

Young People at Work

- *To campaign for age equality in the National Minimum Wage so that all workers receive the highest rate, regardless of age*
- *To work within the union movement and lobby the government for decent job opportunities for young people*
- *To campaign for good apprenticeships in all industrial areas, for decent terms and conditions for interns and for proper training opportunities in general*
- *To tackle age inequality at work including the ending of age rates*
- *For young workers to be treated with respect and to challenge bullying harassment and discrimination against young people at work*
- *To support students, particularly those in part-time work*

Young People in the Wider Community

- *For all young people to have access to free further and higher education*
- *To campaign for affordable housing for young people*
- *To support local youth clubs and services*
- *To work with young people's organisations*
- *To build links with young trade unionists at home and abroad*
- *To initiate and become involved in community activities aimed at young people*

Young People in the Union

- *To increase membership and organisation amongst young workers*
- *To tackle under-representation of young members in Unite at all levels*
- *To increase political involvement of young people in Unite*
- *To equip young members to reach out to other young people at school and beyond*
- *To promote Unite education to young members*
- *To encourage more young members to become Union Equality Representatives*
- *To raise awareness of priorities for young workers throughout the union*
