EXECUTIVE COUNCIL ELECTION

– ADDITIONAL SEATS 2012

The June 2011 Rules Conference amended the rules to allow for national representation on the Executive Council for Disabled and Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual or Transgender (LGBT) members. Accordingly, it is necessary to hold a ballot to elect 2 new members of the Unite Executive Council who shall hold office until 30th April 2014.

Voting in the election

Anyone who was a member of **Unite the Union** on 14 November 2011 is eligible to vote. This does not include retired members.

A fully postal ballot will be held during February. Ballot papers must be returned to The Independent Scrutineer to arrive no later than 22nd February 2012.

A list of all valid nominations made by branches/chapels and workplaces for each candidate will be published with the ballot paper and published on the Unite website.

Electoral Reform Services have been appointed Independent Scrutineer in accordance with the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992 by the Unite Executive Council, see their contact details below.
