In the last Assembly elections they came within 2,500 votes of winning a seat and they hope to do better this time.

recently experienced the consequences of their actions. On January 22nd both organisations protested against local Muslims buying an abandoned social club to use as a cultural centre. While the EDL marched through Shotton the BNP were leafleting the local estate. Days later on February 4th the social club was burned down in a fire which the police have treated as arson.
