Getting Release

UNITE the Union provides the training and pays for your accommodation and meals for the week, also your rail fare to and from Eastbourne or Esher Place.

You should look to secure paid release from your employer.

If you are a shop steward/workplace rep, that shouldn't prove a problem. You have a statutory right to paid release for Union training. If you are a member without an official position, or a branch officer or equality rep who is not a steward, you may have more difficulty. If you do encounter problems, get your Regional Officer involved. Don't give up at the first refusal. In the event of failure to agree, get him or her to contact your Regional Education Organiser. You may be entitled to additional support from the Union.
