Over 16,500 police staff will lose their jobs because of your government's cuts to police forces.

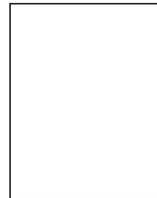
And now the Winsor Report sets out to attack their pay, terms and conditions, as it recommends the abolition of Weekend Working Allowance, the loss of Time Off in Lieu (TOIL), the reduction of stand-by allowances to £15 and pay cuts in real terms by freezing increments.

David Cameron said that 'any cabinet minister who proposed frontline cuts would be sent straight back to think again'.

Police staff are frontline services – How can you fight crime without: scenes of crimes officers, call takers and dispatchers, sex offender managers, detention officers, front office staff, police community support officers, drugs referral workers, arrest referral officers, firearms licensing?
