NHS workers like you are being unfairly targeted to pay for an economic crisis that was not of your making. Your pay has been frozen while the cost of living rises. You face widespread redundancies, cuts and closures of the vital services you provide and our communities rely on.

Now your future dignity in retirement is threatened by government attacks on your pension. **Enough is enough.**

While the unions have tried to negotiate a fair settlement on pensions, the government would not listen. We now have no option but to ballot members working in public services for industrial action commencing on **November 30th.**

5 quick ways to protect your pension

- 1: Check out Unite's campaign materials – visit www.unitetheunion.org/publicpensions. Pass the materials on to your colleagues and encourage them to visit the website to find out how the proposals will hurt them.
- 2: Make sure you get your ballot paper so you can vote. If you don't get your ballot paper by Monday November 7th, please telephone: 020 8889 9203.
- 3: Vote 'Yes' when you get your ballot paper.
- 4: Write to your local paper, tell people how you'll lose out. Calculate your pension using the TUC pension calculator: www.pensionsjustice.org.uk
- 5: Meet with, write to or call your MP. Tell them your pension is fair, affordable and you expect them to help you defend it.
