① Amicus the Lottery is open to all Unite Amicus Section members and their immediate family, aged 16 years or over, living at the same address. Unfortunately legislation on lotteries does not allow members who reside in Northern Ireland, the Republic of Ireland, the Channel Islands or the Isle of Man to participate. Unite and UIA (Group) employees and their relations (even if Unite members) are not eligible to join the Lottery. All net proceeds of Amicus the Lottery will be used to fund union activities.
