Ask your MP for action now!

Please support the campaign to 'Save our NHS' by taking a few simple steps:

In Westminster:

- Raise awareness in Parliament of the concerns and experiences of those at the coalface in the NHS – table questions, speak in the relevant debates in the Chamber, put in for an adjournment or Westminster Hall debate and so on.
- Write to the Secretary of State for Health to make clear both concerns in relation to the White Paper and how cuts are having a detrimental impact to services now.
- Vote against the measures in the Health Bill that are set to destroy our NHS.

In the local area:

- Meeting up with Unite members in your constituency to hear first hand their concerns and how you can help.
- Likewise, get in touch to let us know any local issues or concerns that you are aware of.
- Raise our concerns in your local press, through a press release, writing a letter or covering it in any regular column you make have.
- Write about our/your concerns on your own website.
