The future of Bombardier, the UK's last train maker hangs in the balance as a result of a decision made by the Tory-led government to award a contract to build new trains to a rival company, meaning most of the work will be done in Germany.

As a direct result of the government's decision, the company was forced to announce 1,400 redundancies, but without a new contract the future is now uncertain for Bombardier and all 3,000 jobs are at risk. The government claims to be committed to UK manufacturing but it has dealt a massive blow to the UK's last train maker and the city of Derby.

And it is not just Bombardier workers and their families who are concerned about their futures - thousands more in the supply chain could be affected and this could have a devastating knock-on effect on the East Midland's economy.

The workers, along with their trade unions UNITE, RMT, GMB and TSSA are leading a national campaign to stop this happening to Bombardier workers and their families.

We believe the government has the power to rethink its misguided decision, and secure a future for Bombardier. That would be the right decision for the East Midlands, the right decision for UK manufacturing and the right decision for the economy.

The government must ACT NOW to keep UK rail manufacturing on track and support skilled manufacturing jobs in Derby.
