



CHANGES TO THE RECOGNITION AGREEMENT BETWEEN UNITE/AMICUS & C&G STAFF ASSOCIATION

In 2004 the CGSA agreed to be an integral constituent body of Amicus. Under those arrangements the CGSA continued to operate under its existing name and C&G plc recognised Amicus for employee collective bargaining arrangements. Following discussions with C&G management, it has been agreed to further formalise our relationship with Unite/Amicus and fully integrate the C&GSA into the union. It has been agreed that from the 1st January 2008 Unite will be the only union recognised for collective bargaining for staff in C&G.

What will this mean for staff?

For Unite members, very little will change as you will still enjoy your rights of representation. However, for all CGSA members, from the first of January 2008 you will no longer be able to receive individual representation or advice unless you are a member of Unite.

We urge staff now to consider seriously joining Unite to get the protection that only an

independent trade union can give.
