EWS Railway CSEU representatives requested at the National Council meeting 12th October 05 for EWS and Pension Management to set up pension seminars for EWS staff. The seminars will help EWS staff to plan for their future in retirement. The first seminars will take place at Toton and Margam

At a national council meeting on 13 October 05, your CSEU representatives were able to unify the long-term welfare scheme which EWS has with other affiliated unions. This will mean that all CSEU members will now enjoy the same benefits as the other affiliated unions if they have to leave the company under ill health arrangements, with no loss to shift workers' sick pay. This has been achieved after long and arduous negotiations over the last 2 years with

the EWS management.

Your CSEU representatives are now seeking a lodging allowance for staff working away from home and the introduction of a Christmas bonus.

The CSEU is now joining the Freight on Rail campaign and will be sending representatives to the Rail Union liaison group meeting with the Secretary of State for Transport
