Once we have received your application form we will confirm in writing whether or not you have been allocated a course place. It is up to you to secure your paid release. Employment legislation entitles you to payment of wages etc for training you undertake that is connected with your trade union 'duties' (negotiating, representing people etc.) However, if you have been told by your employer that you won't receive paid release, you must raise the issue with your regional officer before you attend the course.
