### MEMBERS

Feed in policy suggestions and comments through Policy Forums



### NATIONAL POLICY FORUM

Meets 2 or 3 weekends a year to discuss in detail documents produced by the policy commissions. Unite Representatives are there to make sure members' views are included in the policy documents



### POLICY COMMISSIONS

There are 6 Policy Commissions covering all areas of Government, which draw up policy reports for discussion by the National Policy Forum and the Joint Policy Committee. Policy Forum submissions are sent to the Policy Commissions



### JOINT POLICY COMMITTEE

The JPC provides strategic oversight of the NPF work and is chaired by the Prime Minister with members from the NPF and the NEC



### ANNUAL CONFERENCE

Annual Conference remains the sovereign policy making body of the Labour Party. The debates at National Conference are based on the Policy Commission reports and documents. Conference can revise the final policy position through votes on minority and majority positions from the NPF.
