Why the sale of JT will be bad news for Jersey

- **Prices could go up** - If JT is bought by a multinational telecoms giant they will be able to develop a monopoly which could mean higher prices.
- **Up to a third of the workforce could lose their jobs** causing devastation to families and communities.
- **Privatisation will spread** - If Jersey government are allowed to get away with the sale of JT other public companies are sure to suffer the same fate which will mean huge changes to the security and employment of the people of Jersey.

JT a successful company providing a reliable and competitive service and earns the island nearly £13million every year.

The Minister for Treasury and Resources, Senator Le Sueur has been unable to provide any evidence to demonstrate the benefit of a sale to the people and businesses of Jersey apart from a one off payment for the State's reserve fund.

The minister is also trying to push through the sale despite the fact that Jersey, unlike most Western European countries, does not have relevant legislation in place to provide protection of employees' terms and conditions.

There is growing opposition among State members to the sale of JT.
