ARE YOU INTERESTED IN PROMOTING FAIRNESS, EQUALITY AND DIGNITY AT WORK?

If you are then why not become an Equality Rep and help to transform your workplace.

The union is receiving matched funding from the Government's Union Modernisation Fund which involves the development of 400 new Equality Reps throughout the union by January 2010, after which Equality Reps will be rolled out across the whole of the union, in every region and every sector.

Developing fairness and equality in the workplace are key priorities for the union. We need elected Equality Reps who are campaigning for equality and dignity at work and keeping members informed about equality issues and legislation

You may be an existing workplace, learning or H&S Rep who would like to take on the role of an Equality Rep to enhance your personal skills and knowledge. But you don't need to be an existing Rep – you may be a union member who wants to help to tackle inequality, discrimination and bullying in the workplace.

All Equality Reps will receive fully accredited training from the union. Training for the Unite Amicus Section Equality Representatives will begin in the first half of 2009 and to be eligible for this training you must be an elected Unite Amicus Equality Rep.

Don't worry if you are not sure whether the union is recognised as we can find this out for you.
