# IF SO BECOME A REPRESENTATIVE...

***Unite Safety representatives are a key part of providing better Health & Safety for Unite members at work.***

### What do Health & Safety Representatives do?

- Undertake Health & Safety inspections in and around the workplace.
- Raise Health & Safety related matters, identified by staff or by representatives with management.
- Feed into the Health & Safety Committee meetings where representatives from both Unite and NAG meet to discuss the Health, Safety and Wellbeing of NAG staff.

You will be supported throughout your Health & Safety representative role by the Unite NAG team. You will have regular contact and support from your Senior representative and Full Time Officers. Please note applicants must be Unite members.

Safety representatives have specific rights enshrined in law which enables them to inspect workplaces regularly, investigate accidents, dangerous occurrences and potential hazards, including complaints concerning Health & Safety issues in the workplace.

Both NAG and Unite consider this role to be very important, believing it offers a valuable service to Unite and the Company as well as a personal development opportunity.
