Today Lloyds Banking Group made yet another job loss announcement which will add further stress and anxiety to a workforce who has continued to live with uncertainty and job insecurity for over 3 years.

The announcement is a consequence of June's Strategic Review calling on simplification. You can't get it more simple than closing sites down!

The impact will mainly but not exclusively be felt across Wealth and International Division and the decision to close the Group Ops Cash Centre in Birmingham.

There is little doubt that Unite members and colleagues are beginning to feel punch drunk at the continued frequency of job loss announcements which are now nearing a massive 30,000.

Unite will be meeting the Company in the coming weeks to push for a continued commitment that there should be no compulsory redundancies.
