

Justice for Asbestos Victims

Demonstration and lobby to restore pleural plaques compensation

College Green, Houses of Parliament, Westminster, London

The House of Lords decision in October 2007 ended the right of asbestos victims to compensation.

Overnight, thousands of seriously wronged workers were plunged into a compensation limbo. A victim of their employers' negligence, now with Pleural plaques, and a high risk of developing a disease that will kill them, they are now denied justice and the compensation they and their families rightly deserve.

The Lords' ruling was a disaster for working people - but the Government has the power to over-turn it and reinstate compensation for Pleural Plaques sufferers.
