## Teaching for Global Citizenship

*"People are the essential resource to address global challenges"*

This day school is organized in collaboration with the Yorkshire & Humber Regional Active Citizenship Learning Alliance and the Workers' Education Association. The event is for adult education / lifelong learning / workplace tutors and organisers. It will focus on the importance of adult learning - based on equality, sustainability and social purpose - and its key role in enabling action for change at local, national and international levels.

The day will provide the opportunity to:

- Discuss the role of adult education in coherent action for change, as regards current social, environmental and economic problems.
- Look at frameworks for global skills and the key concepts underlying the global dimension in education, as a basis for shared planning and impact assessment
- Exchange success stories; examine the obstacles to active (global) citizenship; and develop strategies for ensuring sustainability of gains made in this area of education.
- Produce a report which can be circulated more widely and possible publication of an academic paper (or papers)

The programme includes:

- A panel of speakers followed by questions and answers
- Examples and analysis of citizenship learning at family, school, community, national, European and international levels
- Discussion groups to share and develop ideas
- Workshops looking at practical resources and approaches
- Action planning: What next?
