# ELECTION OF UNITE WORKPLACE REPRESENTATIVES

The union's national finance sector committee has agreed changes that will be required to our structure to ensure that we are compliant with the new merged Unite rulebook.

Unite are looking for union workplace representatives within LTSB to perform this role.

The period of office is for a maximum of two years and then subject to re-election. All existing workplace representatives will be required to seek re-election. Therefore the procedures are as follows:

3rd March – 31st March	Calls for nominations across the country for members to stand as Unite representatives. Unite's representatives to be nominated by five members in their own workplace region.
1st April – 20th April	Confirm those reps who have been elected unopposed. Where two or more representatives are standing in a site/constituency there will be a need for an election of all members in that site/constituency. Candidates to write an election address to accompany their ballot paper.
21st April	Confirm successful Unite representatives.

## BECOME INVOLVED

Within the Companies/Union workplace agreement [6.9]. Members who are elected as workplace reps are be entitled to time off facilities during their working week to undertake their role, which is to represent and recruit members into Unite. Adjustments to your workload is given. Should you require more information on this then call the union's helpline number on 08081 449 95 95.
