

UNITED ON YOUR BEHALF

Unite the Union is uniquely placed to help members through the inevitable anxiety and change that the proposed takeover of HBOS by LTSB will generate in the coming months and years. Unite is the only union recognised for collective bargaining in both HBOS and LTSB. In HBOS we work across HBOS in partnership with Accord – the union originally for former Halifax staff which is also a TUC affiliate. In LTSB, Unite is the only union recognised right across the LTSB Group. The non-TUC affiliated staff body LTU is recognised in most of LTSB. We also participate, in conjunction with our sister unions, in the LTSB European Employee Forum.

ADVERSITY

At times of adversity for colleagues such as this takeover, only by uniting together can the voice of colleagues be properly heard and their needs protected. For this reason we have written to Accord and LTU inviting them to work with us at this critical time. Accord have responded positively to meet and explore working together and we await a response from LTU.

INFLUENCE

It is notable that the Chancellor has affirmed his desire that jobs be preserved in his Edinburgh constituency. We will be inviting our 150 member Unite group of MPs to do the same and to work together with us to minimise job losses right across the UK, to ensure this is achieved by voluntary means and reduce the detrimental impact on our members and their families. Unite has negotiated excellent agreements with both HBOS and LTSB with regard to Job Security and we will be working to secure the best of those terms are retained.

We are also using our political and media influence to make the case for better regulation in the sector. To this end, we tabled an

emergency motion at the Labour Party conference this week and there will be a special debate in the Scottish Parliament on Weds Sept 24th.

Unite is the largest union in the TUC which exerts a powerful influence on government bodies at both UK and European level.

Unite itself has the resources in terms of media access, finance and people to support our members in whatever strategy they choose to adopt in response to this takeover. Our officers have considerable experience in dealing with the consequences of mergers and takeovers as well as access to advice re their legal, social and industrial implications.

MEETING

Derek Simpson (Joint General Secretary of Unite) has written to the Chief executive of both HBOS and LTSB seeking urgent talks at the highest levels.

We are already meeting with HR from each Company on 24 Sept to initiate the consultation process. Subsequently, we are convening an emergency joint meeting of the Unite HBOS and LTSB National Committees early in October.
