## UNITE PREFERRED CANDIDATES

Applications are now being sought from amongst RBS Group Pension Fund members who wish to be nominated as Trustee Directors. Any active (serving member of staff), deferred or pensioner member of the Group Fund can be nominated to become one of four member elected Trustee Directors. It should be noted however that of the four MND's at least one must be an existing employee and at least one must be a pensioner

The union will not be responsible for forwarding on potential applications.**
