# Workers at TGI Fridays are striking for the first time ever, here's why...

TGI Fridays used to be a pretty good employer-not anymore.

In January, the restaurant chain's waiting staff were given just two days' notice that they'd be losing 40% of the tips customers leave on a card or debit card to the kitchen teams. There was no consultation.

It's not, as the company likes to make out, that they don't want to share. They just don't think they should have to subsidise kitchen staff wages, and who can blame them. These are minimum-waged workers, they rely on tips to pay their bills.

THEN in March, TGI's was number three on the government's list of employers named and shamed for failing to pay workers the national minimum wage and is exposed for not paying new workers for six hour trial shifts.

NOW TGI Fridays workers are taking a stand. It takes real courage to challenge bad practice. Please show your support.
